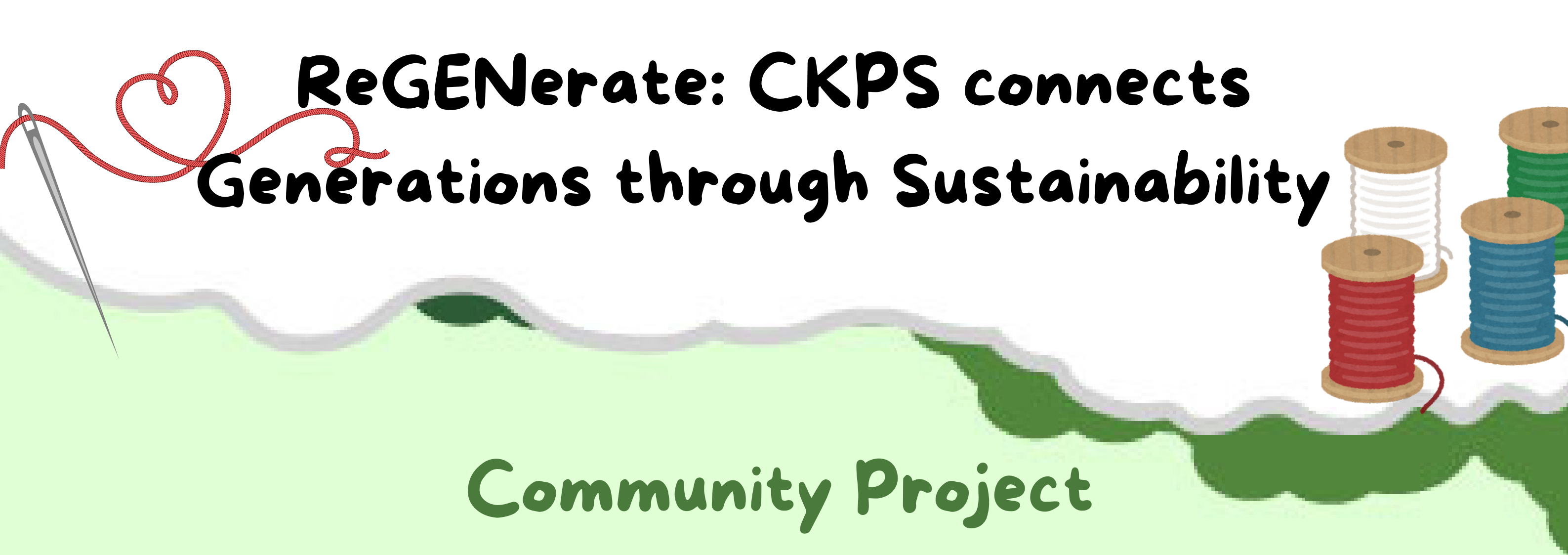




ReGENerate: CKPS connects Generations through Sustainability

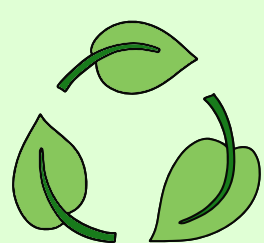
Community Project

Instead of discarding these materials, CKPS, in collaboration with its Parents Support Group (PIE Club), The Circular Classroom, Temasek Polytechnic, Bernina and Changi Simei Community Centre will embark on a large-scale repurposing initiative and invite students, parents and local community to join. We will transform pre-loved CKPS uniforms into handcrafted memorabilia - including keychains, pen holders, cutlery set holders, and pouches - that will be distributed to visitors, alumni, and students during the anniversary event.

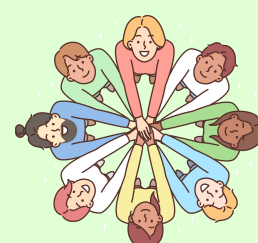

We create awareness among students, parents and all community participants on the SG Green Plan, and train upcycling techniques.

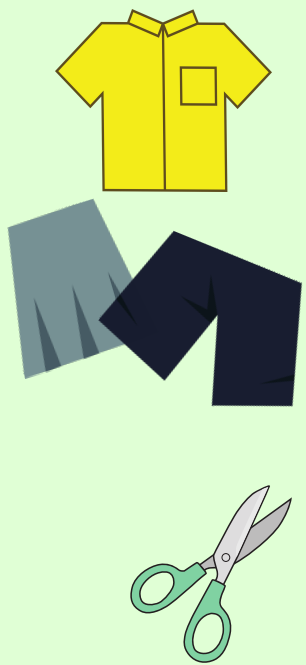


Celebrate CKPS' 60th Anniversary

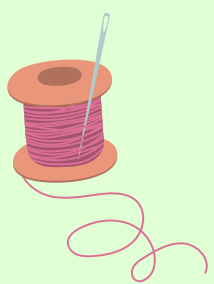


Donate pre-loved CKPS uniforms (ongoing collection at school)

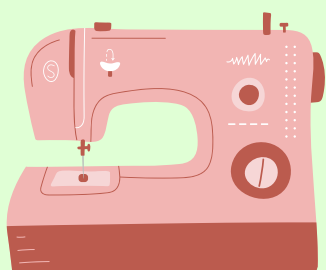
Help cut materials! Students & parents work as a pair. Each student will receive one pre-loved school uniform item in school to cut at home.
