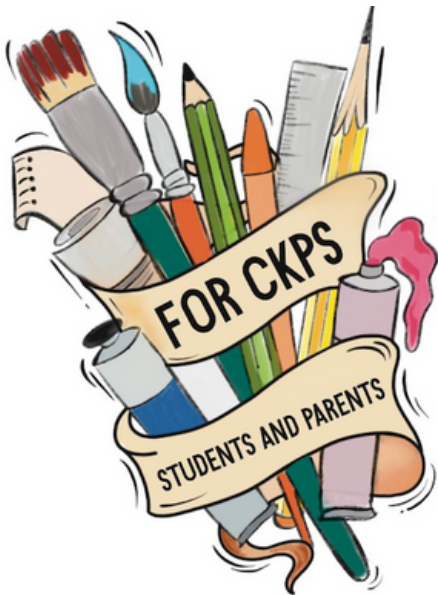


CKPS Goes Green Art Competition Updates from the PIE Club - Part 2



ART COMPETITION

Sustainability and art are closely connected: both invite reflection, aim to raise awareness, and drive change. Through art, students can visually explain complex sustainable development concepts, foster a deeper understanding of sustainable practices, and turn their ideas into powerful calls for action.

In July and August 2023, Changkat Primary School, the PIE Club, and the social enterprise The Circular Classroom collaborated for the first time on a school-wide Art Competition. Under the topic "Imagine your Green School", the competition highlighted the role of schools in promoting sustainability, shaping a green mindset, and instilling sustainable practices in students.

Over 90 students across all levels participated enthusiastically in the competition and shared their vision of a school environment that cultivates a sense of responsibility towards the planet. The artworks – paintings, collages, sculptures and installations – showed remarkable creativity and demonstrated the students' understanding of sustainable practices, from waste reduction and recycling, renewable energy, and ecological balance.

The judging process was both exciting and challenging. The panel of judges, representatives from the education, environment and arts sector, had a difficult task of selecting the winners given the high quality of submissions. Each piece was evaluated based on three criteria: 1) Interpretation of Theme & Storytelling, 2) Creativity & Originality, and 3) Technique & Skill.

The proud winners were announced during the National Day Celebrations at school on 8 August 2023. Guest of Honour, Ms Jessica Tan, Deputy Speaker of the Singapore Parliament and Advisor to East Coast GRC Grassroots Organisations, handed over the awards: a unique CKPS art kit, partially made out of repurposed school uniforms.

To allow everyone to appreciate the talents and dedication of our students and get inspired by their ideas, we intend to feature all artworks in an online gallery and are currently reaching out to the respective parents and students for permission.

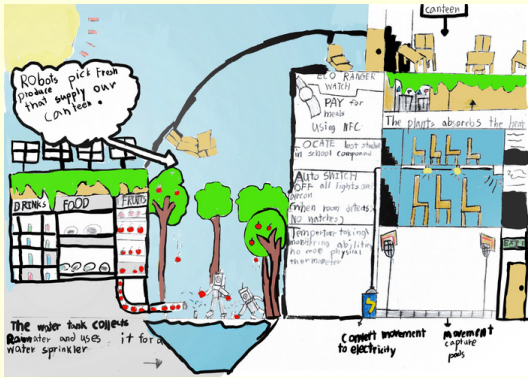

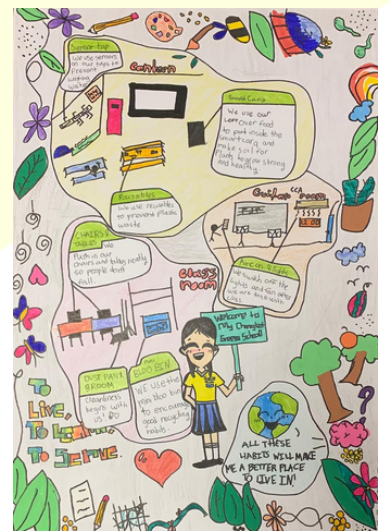
